Pastor: it is of a finite nature and retains all that belongs to a real body.

**People: Even though he, by his resurrection, gave it immortality,**

Pastor: that did not change the reality of his human nature

**People: for our salvation and resurrection depend on the reality of His body.**

Pastor: But these two natures are so united in one person,

**People: that they are not even separated by His death.**
