SERMON NOTES

SERMON TITLE: The Glory of a Second Chance SERMON TEXT: Jonah 3

In chapter 1, the runaway prophet Jonah meets God's judgment as he is hurled into the stormy Mediterranean. In chapter 2, we see him confront God's deliverance as he awakes in the belly of a great fish, gets things straightened out with the Lord, and is vomited onto dry land. In chapter 3, Jonah is given a second chance to go to Nineveh. This time he obeys and declares the message God has given to him for Nineveh. As a result, Nineveh repents from their evil ways, and God relents and does not destroy them.

- 1. Take advantage of God's second chance. (vs. 1-2)
- 2. When you hear the Word of God, you had better do it. <u>Obedience</u> is the key! (v. 3)
- The preacher has no right to <u>proclaim</u> his own message. The authority of preaching comes from declaring the <u>Word</u> of God. (v. 4)
- 4. There is nothing wrong with <u>changing</u> your mind, when it is for the <u>right</u> reason.
 - a. Jonah changed his mind. (v. 3)
 - b. Nineveh changed its mind. (vs. 5-9)
 - c. God changed his mind. (v. 10)
