“Sinners Reconciled by Him Who Had No Sin”
2 Corinthians 5:11-6:2

- I. The message of the gospel is the message of reconciliation:
 - 1) The entire Bible records God's plan of reconciliation (Genesis 3:15)

 - 2) Jesus is the only Mediator through whom we are reconciled to God the Father (18-19; 1 Timothy 2:5)

 - 3) God reconciles us by transferring our sin to Jesus and transferring His righteousness to us when, by grace, we have saving faith in Him alone (2 Corinthians 5:21)

- II. Applications:
 - 1) To be reconciled we must be “*in Christ*” (17a) through saving faith

 - 2) We must show that we are “*new creations in Christ*” by the way we live (15, 17; Galatians 2:20)

 - 3) For any who have not believed in Jesus, “*now is the day of salvation*”, now is the time to have saving faith in Him alone for salvation from sin (2 Corinthians 6:1, 2)
